PRIVATE APPLICATOR?

If you or your employees purchase, mix, or apply Restricted Use Pesticides on property you own or operate in Wisconsin, you MUST be certified to do so. Certification is valid for 5 years.

TWO CERTIFICATION OPTIONS

- 1. Attend a half-day private applicator training session at a local UW-Extension office and take an openbook test after the training. Those that attend a training will need a test score of at least 50% for certification.
- 2. Study on your own and schedule an independent, open-book test at a local UW-Extension office. Those who select the self-study option will need a test score of at least 70% for certification.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR A TRAINING **SESSION OR SELF-STUDY TEST**

- Fill out the attached registration form.
- Register and purchase a General Farming training manual for \$30.00 at a local UW-Extension office (Racine, Kenosha or Walworth) at least one week prior to the training session/desired test date.
 - *The registration form can be sent in and training manuals mailed to you, but only after a check made payable to UW-Extension is received for \$35.00 (\$30.00 fee plus postage).
