

## **Kenosha County 4-H Clover Awards**



The Kenosha County 4-H Clover Award program is an essay contest where young people express their thoughts and feelings on a specific topic. To participate in this program, Kenosha County 4-H members must be first nominated from their 4-H club. Although the nomination process varies from club to club, the criteria for being nominated is based on three factors: achievement, citizenship and leadership. There is no limit on the number of nominations. Youth may be nominated again if they have previously won the award. The categories are

- Cloverbuds
- Elementary 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grade
- Junior 6<sup>th</sup> grade through 8<sup>th</sup> grade
- Senior -- 9<sup>th</sup> through 13<sup>th</sup> grade.

The deadline for Clubs to submit nominees is August 31<sup>st</sup>. Nominees will then receive written instructions including essay topic, length of essay and deadline for submission. All youth who complete an essay will be recognized at the Kenosha County 4-H Awards Night. Three youth in each category will be selected to receive a Clover Award.
