Effective leaders:

1.	Shake hands firmly with every person they meet.
2.	Address people by their surname unless the person requests to be called by their first name.
3.	Advise everyone to turn off cell phones before beginning a meeting.
4.	Make direct eye contact and smile when making introductions.
5.	Greet the eldest person in the room first.
6.	Prefer face to face meetings over phones calls, emails, or letters.
7.	Casually touch the person they are having a conversation with.
8.	Build relationships in order to develop partnerships.
9.	Never write on a business card.
10.	Make others aware of their achievements and highest level of education.
11.	Are aware of hierarchy and who is in charge.
12.	Are permitted to be 10-30 minutes late for a meeting.
13.	Stand very close to a person during a one on one conversation.
14.	Do not introduce themselves to an unfamiliar group, but rather wait to be introduced.
15.	Place the business cards on the table in front of them in the order people are seated during a meeting.
16.	Establish a reputation of being trustworthy.
17.	Know the people they are leading.
