



## Kenosha County 4-H Swine Educational Program Policy

The following are the educational program policies by which the Kenosha County 4-H Swine project will be governed:

- To enroll in the Kenosha County 4-H Swine project youth must be in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade or above.
- In order to represent Kenosha County 4-H countywide Swine project at any Local, State, Regional or National show you must have attended 2 meetings out of 4 in order to be a member in good standing. The swine project member must attend the entire educational meeting in order for it to count.
- College/13<sup>th</sup> year 4-H members should make arrangements with the Swine Educational Team by January 31<sup>st</sup> to apply for alternate learning to satisfy meeting requirements.
- MAQA is required for swine project members, but you do not earn points for attendance. Any member teaching at the MAQA meeting will be given 1 point towards the project year.
- Dues per member will be assessed
