Do You Need the Private Pesticide Applicator Certification?

If you or your employees purchase, mix, or apply **Restricted Use Pesticides** in Wisconsin, you **MUST** be certified to do so. Certification is valid for 5 years.

Pre-Registration Process

- Applicators must pre-register for a class and purchase a training manual. You may also choose to study on your own and take the test at a later date.
- Register and pick up your General Farm training manual at the Walworth, Kenosha, or Racine County Office.
