Session Descriptions:

Sand Candle, Karen and Connor

Make a candle in a unique shape all your own! We will pour wax into a design you can create in sand to make candles. They make great gifts, or keep it for yourself!

Rocketry, Greg

If you are interested in learning how to build a skill level 1 rocket, then this session is for you. During this session you will build a rocket and learn a little bit about what the Kenosha County 4H rocketry project has to offer. Supplies included.

Herb Terrarium, Master Gardeners

You will learn about the drainage that is needed for the container, soil, watering needs, and a variety of herbs. Which herbs companion well together based on their need of water and light. Along with the use of herbs - eating and cooking.

Foods, Raina

Munchy mix – Sweet, salty, crunchy, chewy – when you mix it all together it is delicious! In this session each participant will make their own batch of munchy mix to snack on the rest of the day or take home.

Homemade Nut Butter – Almost everyone has eaten peanut butter, maybe even almond butter... but have you ever tried walnut butter or pecan butter? In this session, we will make and taste homemade nut butters.

Indoor S'mores – We don't usually have a campfire in the winter, so we need to make our S'mores indoors. In this session, we will make a couple of different types of s'mores... no campfire necessary.

Soap, Grace

In this project, members will learn to make different soaps using different molds, bases, scents and colors. Fun for all ages!

Small Animals, Ben, Austin and Katelyn

This session will include information on poultry and rabbits with several activities to test your knowledge. Activities will include showmanship to help you become a better exhibitor. Learn more about showing small animals and how to get started. Also learn about State shows and clubs.

Create with Clay, Megan

Make a sculpture of your favorite animal or movie character. Make a keychain for your backpack or make beads for a necklace!

Rock Painting, Melanie

Paint a rock with your favorite part of 4H inspirational quote. Rocks will be "hidden" in Kenosha for people to find so other will know how great 4H is.

Sewing Stuffed Monster, Melissa

Those signed up will learn and practice skills like choosing a pattern, cutting fabric, machine sewing, and hand sewing. All supplies and tools will be provided, however participants are welcome to bring their own tools, such as a basic sewing kit (pins, fabric scissors, hand needles, seam ripper, measuring tape, and thimble) as well as their own sewing machine. Both beginner and practiced sewers are encouraged to participate!

Leather Working, Leathers 4 U

You'll get a firsthand experience of leather working. It is truly a dying art form. Leather 4 U makes all sorts of products that you will get a chance to learn about.
