

KENOSHA COUNTY 4-H TRIPS AND AWARDS

Wisconsin State 4-H Conference – Madison, WI (4th Week in June)

The Wisconsin State 4-H Conference is a great way to travel, meet new people from around the state of Wisconsin, visit Madison's wonderful attractions, and choose various project areas to learn more about. Some of the fun and educational workshops are kayaking and other water sports, art, photography, poetry writing, and agriculture. *Participation as a delegate is open to all 4-H youth who have completed 6th grade. (The trip costs about \$225 with up to ten \$150 scholarships available from the Kenosha County 4-H Council, Inc.)*

4-H American Spirit Trip – East Cost and Canada (3rd Week in June)

Receive firsthand knowledge of American History over a 10 day period while seeing National Parks, the Empire State Building, Niagara Falls Canada, and much more. *Participants must be in 8th, 9th, or 10th grade. All participants will need a U.S. Passport to attend. (Trip costs about \$1,200 with possible scholarships available from the Kenosha County 4-H Council, Inc.at \$750- four available)*

Citizenship Washington Focus, Washington, D.C. – (one week in June and July)

4-H members ages 15-19 have the opportunity to travel to D.C. with others from the state of Wisconsin and spend a week at the National 4-H Center in Chevy Chase, Maryland. Visit memorials commemorating our nation's leaders and representing our victories and defeats on the battlefield, venture through the Smithsonian Museum, chat with our nation's leaders, and see citizenship in action. *Participants must have completed 9th grade and were at least 15 years of age as of January 1st. (Trip costs about \$1,300 with up to four \$800 scholarships available from the Kenosha County 4-H Council, Inc.)*

National Congress – Atlanta, Georgia (Friday after Thanksgiving)

It takes some forward thinking to prepare for National Congress trip. Considered the flagship of the 4-H trips, it is an opportunity to visit another state with 4-H members across the nation. Service learning and leadership will be key in this six day trip. Criteria for selection includes: 50% on project/activity accomplishments, 25% on 4-H leadership, and 25% on personal, civic and community contributions. *Applicants must have completed 10th grade to apply. Maximum age is 18 as of January 1st. (Trip costs about \$1,000 with four \$750 scholarship available from the Kenosha County 4-H Council, Inc.)*

Key Award

The highest level of award that can be achieved by a 4-H member in the State of Wisconsin, it is an achievement only a few can be proud to receive. The Key Award is presented to 4-H members that have shown growth and strong involvement throughout their participation in 4-H. They also need to show participation in club, and county and community activities. Applicants must have completed at least three years of 4-H and one year of youth leadership. Youth must have completed 10th grade to apply.






1. What are some of the 4-H accomplishments for which you are most proud?
