Session Descriptions:

Rocketry, *Greg*

If you are interested in learning how to build a skill level 1 rocket, then this session is for you. During this session you will build a rocket and learn a little bit about what the Kenosha County 4H rocketry project has to offer. Supplies included.

Honey Bee Hive, *Master Gardeners*

In this session, you'll make a small beehive and learn about what bees need for pollination.

Foods, *Raina*

Munchy mix – Sweet, salty, crunchy, chewy – when you mix it all together it is delicious! In this session each participant will make their own batch of munchy mix to snack on the rest of the day or take home.

Homemade Nut Butter – Almost everyone has eaten peanut butter, maybe even almond butter... but have you ever tried walnut butter or pecan butter? In this session, we will make and taste homemade nut butters.

Indoor S'mores – We don't usually have a campfire in the winter, so we need to make our S'mores indoors. In this session, we will make a couple of different types of s'mores... no campfire necessary.

Soap, *Karen*

In this session, Personalize your own glycerin soap! Make it your favorite color, choose a scent you love, and even add some exfoliating mix-ins.

Melted Crayon, *Danielle*

In this session, placing crayons onto canvas adding tape or paper to make a picture. (paint will be available if needed)

Shrinky Dinks, *Danielle*

Use Sharpies & Draw whatever things that interest you then will cut them out and shrink them.

Tape Canvas, *Danielle*

Add tape to canvas paint with watercolor or tempera a design you would like to have.

Leather Working, *Leathers 4 U*

You'll get a firsthand experience of leather working. It is truly a dying art form. Leather 4 U makes all sorts of products that you will get a chance to learn about.

Interview Manners, *Kim and Corie*

Learn how to prepare for various types of interviews including 4-H trips and awards.

Public Speaking, *Kim and Corie*

Learn how to be comfortable speaking in public and about various types of public speaking -pro/poetry reading, demonstration/persuasive speech.

Theater, *Bob and Sherry*

Come learn the basics of stage presence, blocking, and voice inflection to create character.

Basketry, *Hailey & Angie*

Come learn about how to make a simple basket item.

Drawing, *Frank*

In this session you'll learn about the basic of drawing while drawing.

Paint, *Frank*

In this session learn about using different types of paint and basic ways of painting a picture.

Mixed Media, *Frank*

This session you'll use multiple different paints, drawing pencils and materials to create a picture.
