

# 2020 KENOSHA & RACINE COUNTIES AGRICULTURAL CLEAN SWEEP

Collection & Disposal of Agricultural Chemical Waste

**When: Wednesday, August 19, 1 PM – 4 PM**

**Where: Old Settlers Park (Racine Co Fairgrounds), 19805 Durand Avenue, Union Grove**

If you are an active farmer, owner of agricultural land, nursery, orchard, or greenhouse operator in Kenosha or Racine County you may bring in **up to 200 pounds of agricultural chemical waste free of charge**. There may be charges for waste quantities over 200 pounds depending on program demand and fund availability.

### What WILL be accepted at the Ag Clean Sweep?

- Unusable, unwanted, damaged, registration suspended or canceled agricultural chemicals (including DDT, chlordane, lead arsenate and lindane)
- Other agricultural chemicals including: unusable animal medications and vaccines, teat wash, solvents, degreasers, rodent baits, lead-based paints, etc.
- Waste fuel, antifreeze and motor oil (counted in 200 lbs weight limit)

### What WILL NOT be accepted at the Ag Clean Sweep?

- Empty agricultural chemical containers
- Infectious or biological wastes
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Explosives, radioactive waste
- Freon
- Tires, latex paint
- Computers & electronic equipment
- Human pharmaceuticals

**Unknown Ag Chemicals** will be accepted if they are in quantities of less than 5 gallons or 50 pounds
