



Kenosha County 4-H Scholarship Application 2020

Are you planning to continue your education after high school? Apply for a \$350 Kenosha County 4-H scholarship to help you on your journey! Scholarships will be granted to applicants attending four-year universities or colleges, two-year business, trade, or technical schools, or a vocational agriculture short course.

The recipient must be considered a full-time student at the school where they are enrolled. The recipient must enroll in the educational program of their choice within two years of their high school graduation or forfeit the award.

The Kenosha County 4-H Council will award three scholarships to 4-H members who have **completed grades 10-13**. A 4-H member may apply and be awarded this scholarship more than once.

The deadline for this completed application is **Monday, October 12th, 2020**. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the Kenosha County 4-H Awards Night. Please also email a photo of the applicant, that will be used during the Awards Night, to jen.reese@wisc.edu.
