

# Kenosha County 4-H Trips and Awards Application 2020

This application is for scholarship funds that can be applied towards the total cost of state and national 4-H travel experiences that are described below and for the prestigious Wisconsin 4-H Key Award.

The dates and prices below are our best guess for now, based on previous years, just to give you an idea. This delay is due to COVID-19 and the 2021 information will be shared once it is available\*

#### American Spirit (Northeast United States)

Grades: 8th-10th / Travel: June or July 2021 / Total Cost: \$1400

The American Spirit Experience is an opportunity to develop knowledge of America's heritage, citizenship, and leadership. It is also an opportunity to meet new people, develop leadership and public speaking skills, and travel. Stops often include Valley Forge, Philadelphia (Independence Hall, Liberty Bell), New York (Harbor Tour, 9/11 Memorial, Status of Liberty), Plimoth Plantation/Plymouth Rock, Boston (Freedom Trail, Atlantic Ocean), Whale Watching, and Niagara Falls/Old Fort Erie.

Up to four \$750 scholarships are available from the Kenosha County 4-H Council.

#### Citizenship Washington Focus (Washington, D.C.)

Grades: 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> / Age: Minimum 15 at the time of travel / Travel: June or July 2021 / Total Cost: \$1400

Citizenship Washington Focus is a week-long 4-H citizenship and leadership experience where 4-H delegations from all over the country stay in the National 4-H Conference Center in Chevy Chase, Maryland, right outside our Nation's Capital! Participants learn about the roles of Senators and Representatives in the United States government and how these parts work together to form an effective Congress. Delegates also participate in various educational workshops.

Up to four \$800 scholarships are available from the Kenosha County 4-H Council.

#### National 4-H Congress (Atlanta, Georgia)

Grades: 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> / Age: Maximum 18 as of January 1 of travel year / Travel: November 26-30, 2021 / Total

Cost: \$1200

National 4-H Congress is a week-long experience for 4-H members to network with others from around the country, Canada, and Puerto Rico. Delegates will learn new skills in leadership, community service, goal setting, workforce preparation, and multi-cultural integration. Delegates also participate in educational workshops focusing on diversity, cultural experiences, leadership, and team development. **Up to four \$750 scholarships are available from the Kenosha County 4-H Council.** 

#### Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference (Madison, WI)

Grades: 7<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> / Travel: Late June 2021 / Total Cost: \$225

Wisconsin 4-H & Youth Conference is a three and a half day Statewide Educational Experience. Youth from all over Wisconsin come to Madison for educational seminars, assemblies, speakers, exploration, and fun on the UW-Madison campus! Youth Conference is a pre-college program and a variety of seminars are taught by Extension professionals and UW-Madison professors. Up to ten \$150 scholarships are available from the Kenosha County 4-H Council.

#### Wisconsin 4-H Key Award

### Grades: 9<sup>th</sup> + / Applicants must have completed three years of 4-H and one year of youth leadership.

The Wisconsin 4-H Key Award program recognizes a select group of 4-H participants who have demonstrated consistent growth in their 4-H involvement, developed and applied leadership skills, and actively participated in the functions of their 4-H club and community. Selection of Key Award recipients will be based on an evaluation of the candidate's total 4-H record.
