- Clarity of thought
- Clearly answered the question asked
- Grammar, spelling, and punctuation
- Involvement in 4-H
- Maturity for your grade
- Optimism and enthusiasm
- Originality
- Stayed within the word limit

You may neatly handwrite your response, but typing is preferred. Be sure to keep the length of your response within your word limit as outlined below. Be sure to include your name and grade category on the top of your response document. Award recipients will be announced at the Kenosha County 4-H Awards Night.

Category/Grade (2019-2020): Cloverbud/K-2nd

Word Limit: 100

Question: From the 4-H pledge, what are some ways you have used your “hands for larger service?”

Category/Grade (2019-2020): Elementary/3rd-5th

Word Limit: 150

Question: From the 4-H pledge, what does the phrase “health for better living” mean to you?

Category/Grade (2019-2020): Junior/6th-8th

Word Limit: 250

Question: From the 4-H pledge, what are some ways you have used your “head for clearer thinking?”

Category/Grade (2019-2020): Senior/9th-13th

Word Limit: 350

Question: From the 4-H pledge, what are some ways you have used your “heart for greater loyalty?”
