

Preparing for your YAR Interview

- Dress for success "professional" attire is appropriate.
- Arrive 15 minutes early give yourself time to "catch your breath" and collect your thoughts before the interview.
- There will be both adults and youth from the Youth As Resources Board on the interview committee.
- The interview will be 10 minutes. There will be time at the end for you to ask questions.
- Listen carefully to questions posed by the interview committee members. If you do not understand the question, ask for clarification.
- Be able to answer the question "What do you know about YAR and their sponsors?"
- Respond to questions by speaking clearly and confidently. Use eye contact with committee members.
- Be prepared to showcase your positive qualities know your own strengths.
- Watch your body language relax and sit naturally; avoid chewing gum or fidgeting with jewelry or your hair.
- Let your personality shine!
