Preparing for your YAR Interview

- ◆ Dress for success – “professional” attire is appropriate.
- ◆ Arrive 15 minutes early – give yourself time to “catch your breath” and collect your thoughts before the interview.
- ◆ There will be both adults and youth from the Youth As Resources Board on the interview committee.
- ◆ The interview will be 10 minutes. There will be time at the end for you to ask questions.
- ◆ Listen carefully to questions posed by the interview committee members. If you do not understand the question, ask for clarification.
- ◆ Be able to answer the question "What do you know about YAR and their sponsors?"
- ◆ Respond to questions by speaking clearly and confidently. Use eye contact with committee members.
- ◆ Be prepared to showcase your positive qualities – know your own strengths.
- ◆ Watch your body language – relax and sit naturally; avoid chewing gum or fidgeting with jewelry or your hair.
- ◆ Let your personality shine!
